To Make Man Whole



ACADEMIC COSTUME

The practice of wearing academic dress for commencement and other special events evolved from fourteenth-century custom and at least in part from the statutes prescribing everyday student garb in British and European institutions. A code governing academic costume for American colleges and universities was the outgrowth of a conference in 1895 by representatives of various interested institutions. Review and revision of the code was made in 1932 and again in 1959 by the American Council on Education. The code standardizes academic costume (gown, hood, and cap) distinctive of the three titles conferred – bachelor, master, and doctor.

GOWN. The usual color for the gown is black.... The *sleeve* indicates the degree of the wearer: BACHELOR, long, open, pointed, the tip extending below the hip; MASTER, oblong, square at the back, an arc at the front, the tip extending below the knee; DOCTOR, voluminous, bell-shaped, wrist-length.... *Velvet bands* identify the doctor's gown, a wide panel on either side at the front opening and three narrow bands across the upper portion of the sleeve. This velvet trimming may be black but is often the color indicative of the branch of learning.

HOOD. The most colorful and distinctive item of the costume is the hood, which is attached at the front a few inches below the neckline, passes over the shoulders, and extends loosely down the back. . . . The hood is *lined* with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree, and these colors are worn exposed where the hood turns outward at the center back. The band of *velvet* at either side of the center turnback and around the front loop of the hood is the color indicative of the branch of learning of the wearer. . . The *style* of the hood indicates the degree: BACHELOR, three feet long, pointed, two-inch velvet band; MASTER, three and a half feet long, pointed, three-inch velvet band; DOCTOR, four feet long, paneled at the side to give a rounded appearance at the lower edge, five-inch velvet band.

COLORS. The hoods of candidates and graduates of Loma Linda University are lined with a *field of gold* on which is a *purple chevron*. Some of the hoods seen in the Faculty procession identify graduates of the following universities:

Boston, white on scarlet California, yale blue on gold Cambridge, bright red Chicago, maroon Columbia, white on light blue Emory, gold on navy blue George Washington, buff on dark blue Harvard, crimson Illinois, orange on navy blue Iowa State, old gold over cardinal Iowa, old gold Maryland, old gold on black Michigan, azure blue on maize Montana State, goldenrod on royal blue Nebraska, scarlet over cream Northwestern, gold on purple Ohio State, gray on scarlet Oregon, emerald green on lemon yellow Saint Louis, yale blue on white Southern California, cardinal on gold Stanford, cardinal Washington, purple over gold Colors associated with branches of learning (shown in velvet in the trimming on hoods and in some cases on the front and sleeves of the gown) are:

dentistry, *lilac* education, *light blue* law, *purple* liberal arts, *white* library science, *lemon* medicine, green nursing, apricot pharmacy, olive philosophy, dark blue public health, salmon science, gold yellow social work, citron theology, scarlet

American College of Dentistry, American red rose and lilac velvet panels American College of Surgeons, navy blue gown, red velvet panels American College of Physicians, embroidered insigne on right sleeve American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, forest green cap and gown with dark green velvet trimming and chevrons

CAP. The standard black cap (the so-called mortarboard, derived from the cap of Oxford University) is worn both indoors and outdoors with academic costume. The *tassel* is black for the bachelor's or master's degree at this University; candidates for the doctor's degree wear the gold... Faculty members wearing soft caps somewhat resembling an overlarge beret hold degrees from universities outside the United States.
