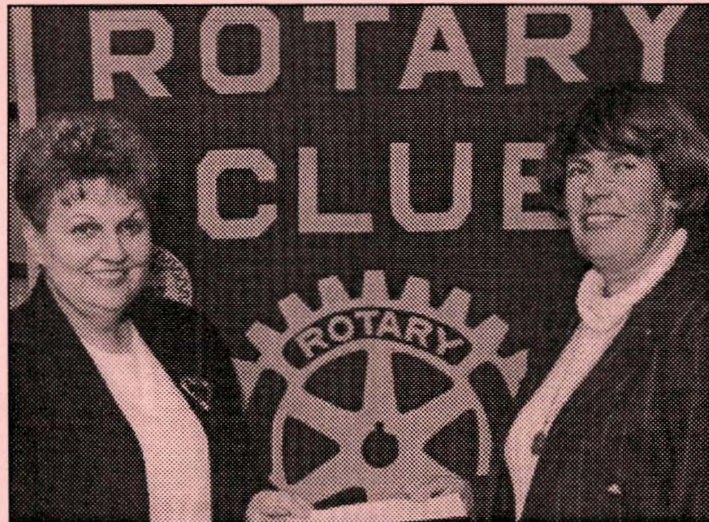

Implant dentistry

Nick Caplanis, DDS, assistant professor, lectured at the annual meeting of the European Academy of Osseointegration in Paris, France, on February 8. His topic was *Peri-implant Bone Regeneration*.

Monica Bijlani, DDS, senior resident, lectured for the Osseointegration Study Club of Southern California on January 5 at the Four Seasons Hotel in Newport Beach. Her lecture was on *Surgical reconstruction of the Interdental Papilla—a clinical case study*.

She will lecture on March 2 for the Academy of Osseointegration at the Marriott Marquis Hotel in New York City. She will also present a paper on the *Immediate loading of dental implants: influence of early functional contacts on implant stability, bone level integrity and soft tissue quality—a retrospective three year analysis* at the Oral Research Scientific Session annual meeting. Her paper was one of 11 chosen from a record number of 97 admitted this year.
