
This season can be for you whatever you want. Are you on fast forward, out of control? Will you take the time to slow down and come in contact with yourself, surroundings and your family as well as your friends?

We are happy to share with the School of Dentistry family the wonderful comments that have been submitted this past year and look forward to all your nominations in the year ahead.


