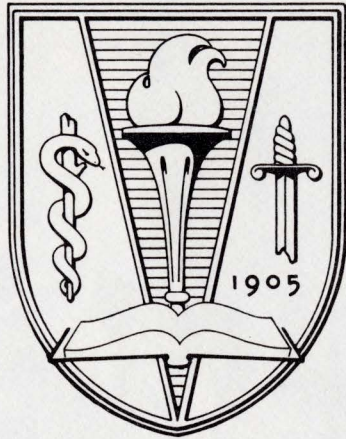

## GENEVA RICHARD JOHNSON

Associate Professor of Physical Therapy  
Baylor College of Medicine, Department of Rehabilitation

Dr. Johnson is an alumna of the University of Southwestern Louisiana (B.S. 1942), the United States Army, Lawson General Hospital (certificate in physical therapy, 1946), the University of Southern Carolina (M.A. 1959), and the University of Pittsburgh (doctorate in higher education administration, 1971). After receiving her certificate in physical therapy, Dr. Johnson worked as a staff therapist for eight years in Texas, Iowa, and Colorado. From 1959 until 1974 Dr. Johnson was part of the faculty and administration of Case Western Reserve University (formerly Western Reserve University) in Cleveland, Ohio. Positions she held there included assistant professor of physical therapy; director, graduate physical therapy curriculum; assistant dean, general administration and continuing education; associate professor, higher education, School of Nursing; and assistant dean, curriculum development and continuing education, School of Nursing. From 1974 to 1983 she was director of the Department of Physical Therapy in the Institute for Rehabilitation and Research at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, Texas. At the same time she also held her present position as associate professor of physical therapy in the Department of Rehabilitation. Throughout her career she has held office in numerous professional associations, including the American Physical Therapy Association. She is the founder of the Physical Therapy Directors' Forum, Greater Houston Area; and of the Society for Behavioral Kinesiology, Inc., of which she is currently the director of the board of directors. She is widely published on the subject of physical therapy education and has presented many papers, workshops, and seminars in North America and Europe. Dr. Johnson is the recipient of a variety of honors, the latest of which is the Mary McMillan Lecture Award presented by the American Physical Therapy Association.
